- In finding Gods call for me, I was challenged to read the Bible and pray for 1 hour every day I am really going to try to do that. I also want to try to be a Christian that can lead someone else to Christ. One thing I would like to stop doing is talking back to my parents.
- Be more careful as to what I listen to and watch. Look more into what the point of the media I like is. Try to surrender my life more to God. Dress more modest and not distracting. Look for what I'm good at so I can find my calling. Be more content in what I have and realize I'm truly rich. Try to be a woman of God and show it to the world.
- I want to go to South Africa. I have always wanted to be a missionary there. My hope is to be a part time missionary.
